



## **Draper Park Middle School Information regarding Mathematics - Honors**

Honors classes are offered in Mathematics for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. Students are most successful in honors classes when they have higher prerequisite skills.

Students interested in honors placement will need their parent to complete the online honors request form. This link can be located on the Draper Park Middle School home page. Please complete the Honors Request form by April 21<sup>st</sup>. Placement of qualified students into an honors class after that date cannot be guaranteed.

The two data points that will be used to determine placement into 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade math honors placement are the Scholastic Math Inventory (SMI) and the Student Assessment for Growth and Excellence (SAGE).

- SMI
  - For 7<sup>th</sup> grade honors an advanced score  $\geq$  1130 on the SMI
  - For 8<sup>th</sup> grade honors an advanced score  $\geq$  1180 on the SMI
- SAGE math (District End of Year CFA if SAGE is not available)
  - For both 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade honors a highly proficient rating (level 4) on SAGE

Students achieving both these benchmarks will be placed in honors math. Students achieving one of the two benchmarks will be placed in honors math as space is available.

Transfer students requesting honors will need the 2 data points listed above. If SAGE scores are not available, counselors/administrators will administer End of the Year Assessments. There will be one day scheduled in June and one day scheduled in July to administer these assessments.
