



*Science Portfolio Requirements  
Due February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to the  
Student Center by 3:00 PM*

*Student portfolios are due to the Student Center by February 28, 2018.*

Portfolios should contain the following:

- Two assignments from science class. Each assignment should have a reflection explaining why the piece was chosen and what you learned from the assignment. Some guidelines for choosing assignments:
  - One assignment that shows master of the content
  - One assignment that shows need for improvement
- A PowerPoint presentation highlighting a STEM career that you are interested in. The PowerPoint should include on each slide a picture, interesting background, and transitions. The PowerPoint should also be clear, concise, free of grammatical errors, written in complete sentences, NOT plagiarized, and include a works cited page in APA style using Noodle Tools.
- PowerPoint slides also address the following points:
  - Best attribute of the job
  - Skills required to be hired for the job
  - The level of education required for the job
  - The benefits of the job (including the salary)
  - Why you are interested in it
  - How it relates to your science courses you have taken at Draper Park
- You should print your PowerPoint for your portfolio, and also plan to present it at the interview, as well as answer questions for consideration.
- A five paragraph essay (typed, double spaced, 12 pt. font) on the role science plays in sustaining the Earth. The essay should be clear, concise, free of grammatical errors, written in complete sentences, NOT plagiarized, and include a works cited page in APA style using Noodle Tools.

The interviews will be conducted on March 30, 2018.
