

## Team Tyr Help Sheet 2017 - 2018

1. CLASS TIME	Instruction occurs each day. Please ask questions whenever you do not understand a concept and be punctual, focused, and on-task during each class period. Also, be honest when asked to rate your understanding, so we know immediately if you need clarification or personalized instruction.
2. RETEACHING	At least one day a week, you will have the opportunity to be retaught concepts you are struggling with understanding. This will be completed in small group instruction during class.

7. ONLINE HELP	We will post unit resources, starters, agendas, and objectives on Canvas. If you are asked to view them for homework, make sure you complete the task when it is assigned. 8. PRACTICE QUIZZES	As we progress through our units, you will take frequent practice tests to check your mastery of the concepts we are studying. If you have not yet mastered the concept, commit to seeking out help during small group instruction and after school, and studying your notes.
9. MAKEUP WORK	Our main goal in 6th grade is to prepare students for success in middle school. This requires high expectations for work being turned in on time. Late work will be accepted NO LATER THAN THE UNIT TEST DAY. No makeup or late work will be accepted the last week of the trimester. Students with missing, late work will be unable to retake a quiz until it is completed.
