

# Dance Portfolio Viking Scholar

Performing Arts Portfolio and Interviews are closed to the public.

Requirements for the Dance Portfolio:

- Application (Submitted Online by January 13)
- Portfolio: Solo choreography, Essay (due February 27, 3:00, to the Student Center)
- Interview: Choreography performance, interview, discussion (scheduled on March 27)

## **PORTFOLIO**

Essay: The essay should be 1 page, typed, double-spaced

Discuss your inspiration for the choreography piece you designed.

Use the following questions to guide you:

- What inspired you to choose the theme or idea you chose?
- How does the music fits correspond to your choreography? How did the piece of music you chose inspire you?
- What you are trying to express through your movement? Explain how you came up with the movement and what *Elements of Dance* were used and why.

#### **SOLO CHOREOGRAPHY**

- 1. Contemporary (Modern) style only.
- 2. Two minutes in length: Instrumental music only.
- 3. Must include creative movement choices that match musicality and theme. Stay away from "tricks". Exp: Fouettes, acrobatics, leaps, etc. Your movement should be innovative. Only put in movement that creates a picture of what you want to express.
- 4. Incorporate the *Elements of Dance* into your piece and be prepared to discuss the ones you chose and why.
- 5. No props or sets should be used. Only the dancer.
- 6. No costumes are allowed. Please wear all black dance clothing with your hair pulled back. No socks allowed.

### **IMPROVISATION**

After the dancer performs their solo choreography, they will then be asked to do an improvisation based on either a picture shown or from a description. The dancer can take as long as necessary to finish the movement.

#### **INTERVIEW**

Dance will interview and discuss their essay, choreography, application and improvisation with the judges.
