## Notification of Upcoming SCC Election

The Draper Park Middle School Community Council consists of six school employees and nine parent members who are elected for a two-year term, The purpose of the School Community Council is to build connections between the school and community it serves, provide consistent and effective communication, and ensure that parents have a voice in and are actively involved with their children's education. Together, the SCC works with teachers and administrators to further academic success at DPMS.

The council meets the second Wednesday of each month with the exception of holidays and December, June, July, and August. Meetings will begin at 3 pm.

For the 2020-2021 school year, five members will be returning for their second term, which leaves four openings for this school year.

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to place your name on the SCC ballot! If you are interested, please send:

1. Your name (as you would like it to appear on the ballot),
2. A short paragraph (150 words or less) letting people know who you are and why you are running for SCC
3. Your phone number (this will not be on the ballot),
4. Your Email address (this will not be on the ballot), and
5. Your student's name. The only stipulation for being on the council is that you must have a child attending Draper Park Middle at the time of elections. (This will not be on the ballot). Parents of students who opt for online or district supported, home directed learning *are* eligible to run for SCC.

Names are due to the principal, Chip Watts, by July 31, 2020.

The ballot box to collect the votes will be placed in the main office at Draper Park Middle. School staff will highlight the name of each parent voting then parents will drop their ballot in the ballot box. One ballot per person, please. Ballots must be returned to the ballot box no later than 3:30 pm on August 17<sup>th</sup>.
