- b. School Report Card comes from 23-24 RISE Data
 - i. We are in the commendable range: ELA and Math Average; Science -High
 - ii. We are in the Typical Range for English Learners'. They are making adequate progress. We are "killing it" on proficiency
 - iii. Compared to the district and state we have gone down a few points
 - iv. Our growth is not much higher than the state data
- c. Math TSSP Goals

Proposed Goals for 25-26 School Year:

- i. Increase the number of students proficient on the Math RISE from 57% to 59%
- ii. In the 25-25 school year, DPMS will achieve the 50th percentile for growth on the MAP test on the winter and spring administrations.

Action Steps

iii. Promote and Celebrate MAP Growth: educate parents on MAP scores via Parent Square; provide scores at PTC; have students reflect on MAP data

- and make goals; educate students on importance and encourage high level of participation; celebration for students who make a 50% percentile growth with a treat; more conferences with students who are not doing well
- iv. Data Days: provide additional time for teachers to look at data substitutes to cover their class;
- v. Improve PLCs: send a team of 10 teachers to a PLC conference; monthly PLC agenda item to reflect on TSSP goals and reflect; train teachers on Common Formative Assessments (CFA); PLCs will reflect on CFA data at least monthly; admin will help facilitate PLC content team visits to see other effective PLC meetings
- vi. Instructional Focus: teachers will utilize the Three Reads Strategy; teachers will use CFA, implement the Building Thinking Classrooms; teachers will participate in public practice by observing other teachers in the same content area
- vii. Vertical Teaming: collaboration one Friday afternoon for vertical alignment
- viii. Math Lab Class (Math 180): funds for 3 math lab classes (taught by math teachers), funds for 3 Math 180 classes to support students who qualify for them during the school day
 - 1. Math 180 focuses on filling in gaps for students that fall in the red and orange range on testing
 - 2. Math Lab classes to preteach concepts for students that fall in the yellow range on testing
- ix. Math Tutoring: continue to offer 2x/week with math teachers.
 - 1. We currently average 15-20 students/day
- x. Instructional Aides: hire 3 28-hr instructional aides to help math teachers
- xi. Other Needs: summer transition days for teachers to organize and prepare for next year, supplies and materials, textbooks, printing costs
- d. English TSSP Goals

Proposed EIA Goals for 25-26 School Year

- Increase the number of students proficient on the LEA RISE from xx% to xx%
- ii. DPMS will achieve the 50th percentile for growth on the Reading MAP test on the winter and spring administrations.

Action Steps:

- iii. All teachers will give the MAP test and utilize the Reading Information Text section of MAP
- iv. MAP Growth: educate parents on MAP scores via Parent Square; teachers will provide printouts at PTC; students will reflect on MAP data and make goals 2x/year; celebration for students who have made the 50th percentile growth, conferences with student/parents
- v. Data Days: meet with ELA and social studies teachers, work with elective teachers had have them participate in literacy based learning through the school year

- vi. Improve PLCs: same as Math action plan
- vii. Instructional Focus: continue to emphasize reading informational text; use CFA; Implement QTEL strategies in their classroom
 - 1. QTEL: Quality Teaching for English Learners
- viii. Vertical Teaming: All English teachers meet together
 - ix. Professional Development: funds for teacher directed professional learning
 - x. Read 180 and Literacy Classes: Provide funds for 4 Read 180 classes that will support students who qualify for them during the school day; 2 English Development classes for ML students/Newcomers; Increase Special Education FTE allocation;
 - 1. Newcomers: new to country don't speak any English
 - 2. Will move to Lit 1 class phonics based class
- xi. General Tutoring and Homework Help: after school intervention
- xii. Instructional Aides: hire 3 aides for ELA teachers, hire a 28-hr aide to support with intervention classes
- xiii. Other Needs: compensation for SPED/ML/504 transition hours
